Tricks I –

Examples of Tricks that may be covered: Stand, Back up, Hugs, Kiss, Shake/Wave, Head down, Spin left, Spin Right, Circle owner, holds object in mouth*

Tricks II –

Further your trick repertoire with some more advanced tricks. These will really impress your friends and family

Examples of Tricks: Roll over, Bow, Play dead, Weave between owners legs, cover nose, chase tail, crawl*

*Not all tricks mentioned will be covered.

Who are these classes for?

Working Spots: For **dog/owner teams** that wants to strengthen the bond with their dog, learn how to teach their dog fun and creative games and trick. The dog is at least 4 months of age with Basic Obedience skills: Sit, Down, Come, Leave It & Stay and the handler is at least 14 years of age with a working relationship with the dog being trained.

Auditing Spots: For any dog owner that wants to strengthen the bond with their dog, while learning how to teach their dog fun and creative games and tricks.
